CALLING THE NATIONAL

As the National is a jackpot game, there are more rules and procedures involved;

- When calling the National Game, you should ensure that the customers are playing the correct flyer as once you start calling the numbers there can't be any check backs (this is when you stop the game and read back called numbers from the lowest to the highest).
- You need to let the customers know that it is a full house game and tell them what the prize money is. You also need to make them aware of the jackpots in play. These are:
 - o Call on 24 numbers or less for an extra £100
 - o Call on 20 numbers or less for an extra £1000
 - o Call on 16 numbers or less for an extra £50,000

Once you have let them know of the jackpots in play you should say, *"We are now playing the National flyer, we are playing for a Full house, your first number is..."*

The National flyer needs to be **triple called i.e. 35... 3 and 5... 35** this gives the customer more time to shout. Once you have a claim;

- If it is on a board; You will need to hit 'ENTER' to validate the claim and say *"We have a claim on 45, are there any further claims? No further claims, that's a good claim, 45 appears on that card, are there any more?"*
- *"No more then, the National flyer is closed with the one winner"*
- If they haven't won a jackpot, say *"The house was called on 26 numbers so unfortunately too many numbers for the jackpots"*.
- If they have won a jackpot, the screen will display which jackpot they have won, in this case you should say, *"You called the house on *21* numbers so you take away an extra *£100* well done"*.

Once you have closed the game you need to make sure you are aware of who has won as their information needs to be put into the National game workstation. If you are unsure of the winner you should announce, *"Could the winner of the game raise their hand please"*. This will allow the 'floor person' to find them.

Then make sure you have reset the game by **double clicking the red button**.

AN EXAMPLE OF A NATIONAL FLYER SCRIPT

“That takes us on to your National Flyer, please make sure it is the purple and white National Flyer ticket you are playing because once I start calling there can be no checkbacks”

“It is a straight through full house game, the prize money is...”

“There are a few jackpots in play, if you call the full house on 24 numbers or less you get an extra £100, call on 20 numbers or less and you get an extra £1000 and call the full house on 16 numbers or less and you will win an extra £50,000!”

“The National game rules are now in play, if we are all ready, your first number is.....”

“We have a claim on 45 are there any further claims? No further claims”

“Checking position 1035, that’s a good claim 45 does appear on that card is there any more”

“No more then that’s the National flyer closed with the one winner well done.”

“Unfortunately, it was called on 25 numbers, too many to win one of those jackpots”

Or

“And you called it on 20 numbers so you take way an extra £1000 well done”

“If the winner could just raise your hand for me, please, thank you”
